Year 3 Hoo Farm Visit

As part of our topic work this term we are planning a visit to Hoo Farm on Friday 31st March. We shall leave school at approximately 9:30am and to return to school in time for the normal end of the school day at 3:15pm.

The children will need a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate) for those children who have free school meals a packed lunch can be provided. As it will be a full day the children may bring a healthy snack for the morning. Please could their lunches be packed in either plastic containers or disposable packaging, and placed in a rucksack type bag, as they will be responsible for carrying this with them all day.

Your child does not need to wear their school uniform but they do need to wear their school jumper and sensible footwear or Wellington Boots. Please do not send the children with any money as there will not be an opportunity to purchase anything.

The full cost of the visit is £10.50 however; [the fundraising which took place last term enables us to reduce the cost per child](#). This means in order for the trip to go we need a contribution of £7.50 for each child. Thanks to the efforts of our fundraising team we didn't have to cancel any trips last year and, as the visits we plan are all organised with a view to enhancing your child's learning, that is a great achievement.

If you do have any difficulties with the contribution you must speak to us at your earliest convenience. If we do not receive enough contributions by 17th March then, unfortunately, the trip will have to be cancelled.

We can only offer trips and activities with the support of all the parents. If we do not receive enough contributions then unfortunately the trip will have to be cancelled.
